The Portrait Gallery

1,600 sq ft | Maximum Capacity: 60

A sophisticated pre-function and reception space defined by herringbone flooring, marble architectural detailing, curated artwork, and an integrated bar. Ideally suited for guest arrival, networking receptions, seated dinners, and flexible meeting configurations.



The Lodge Room

1,500 sq ft | Maximum Capacity: 60

The architectural centerpiece of Freemasons' Hall. Defined by vaulted ceilings, sculptural stone detailing, and integrated ambient lighting, the Lodge Room provides a commanding setting for keynote addresses, executive presentations, and formal programs.



The Study

1,500 sq ft | Maximum Capacity: 30

An intimate, club-style environment designed for executive breakout sessions, private dining, strategy meetings, and fireside conversations. Ideal as a VIP lounge, leadership retreat room, or post-program gathering space.
